Veterans Day

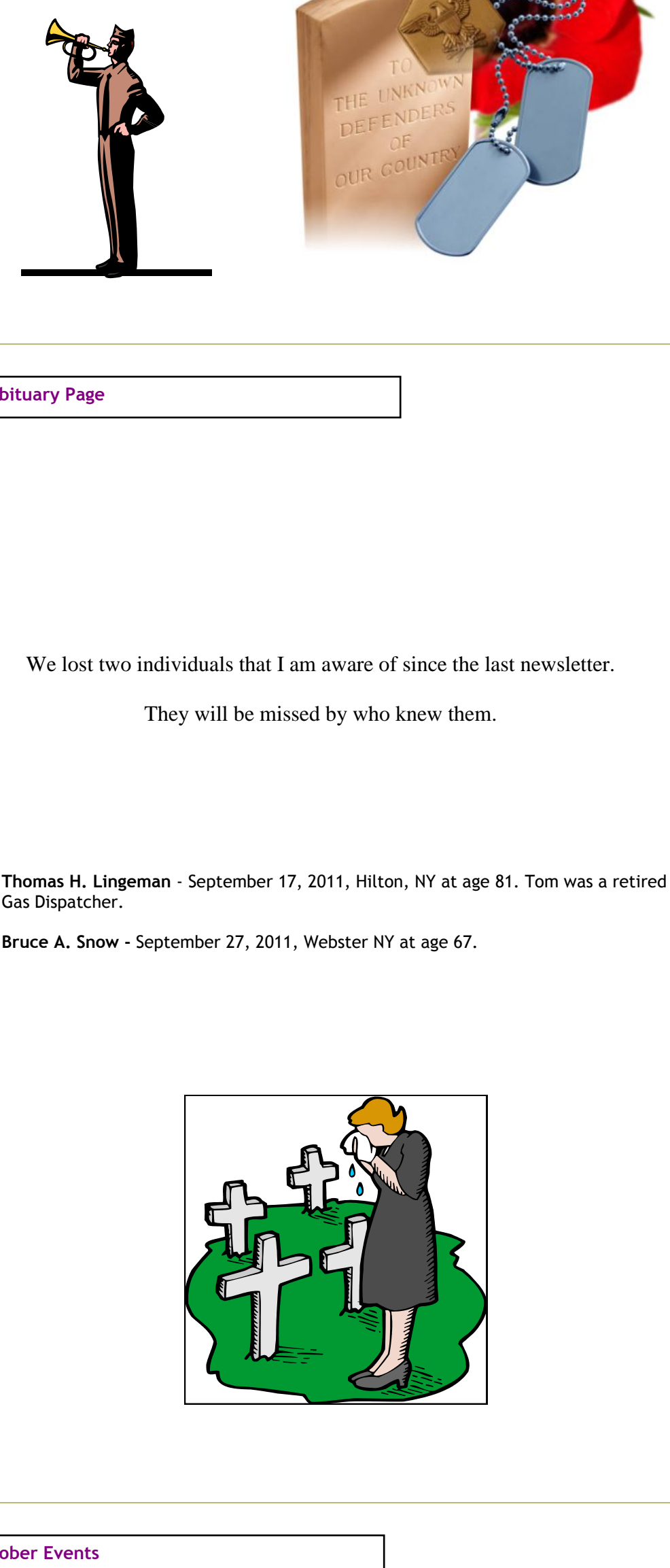
This is an early reminder of an upcoming event.

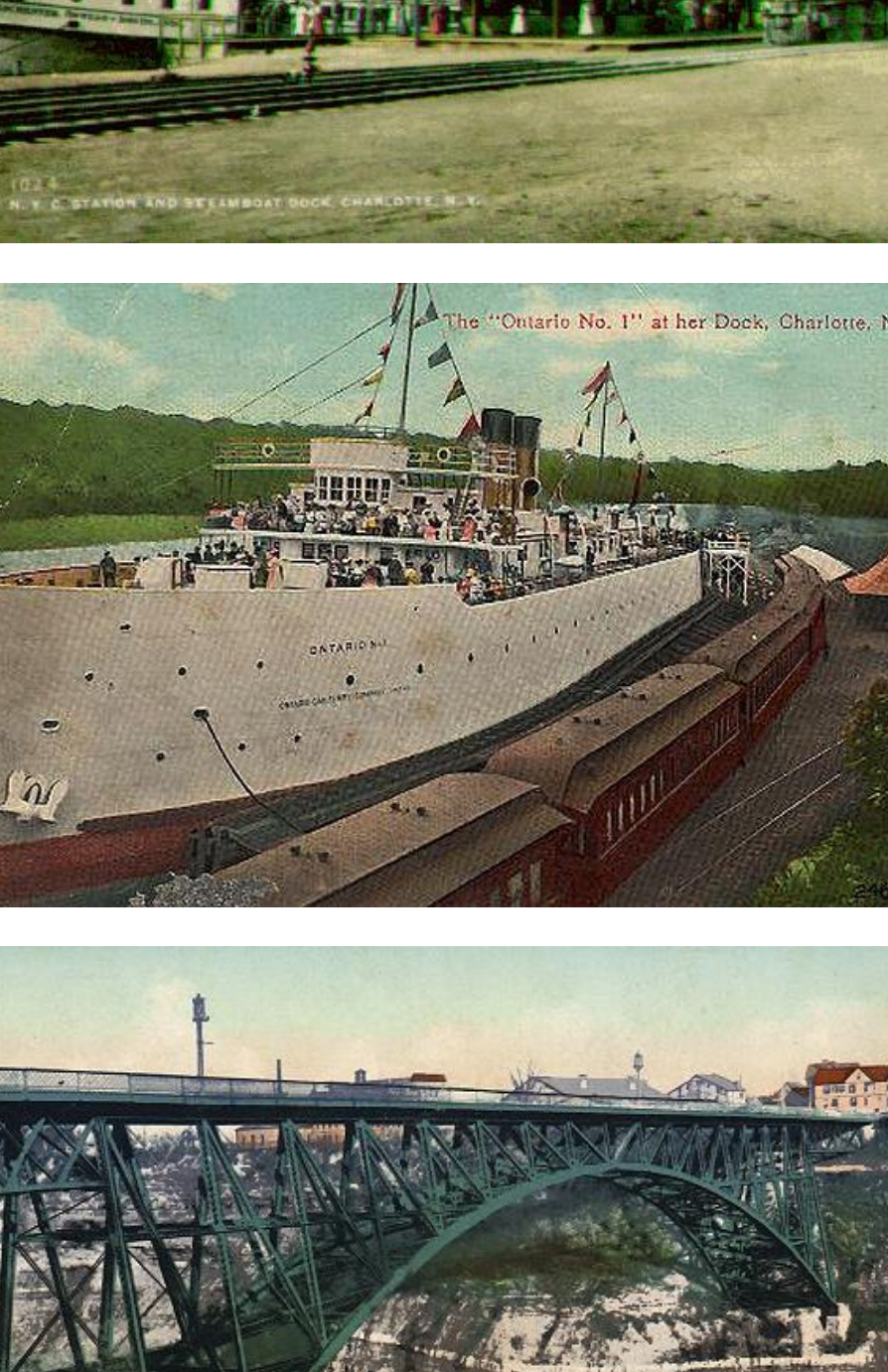


Russell Station

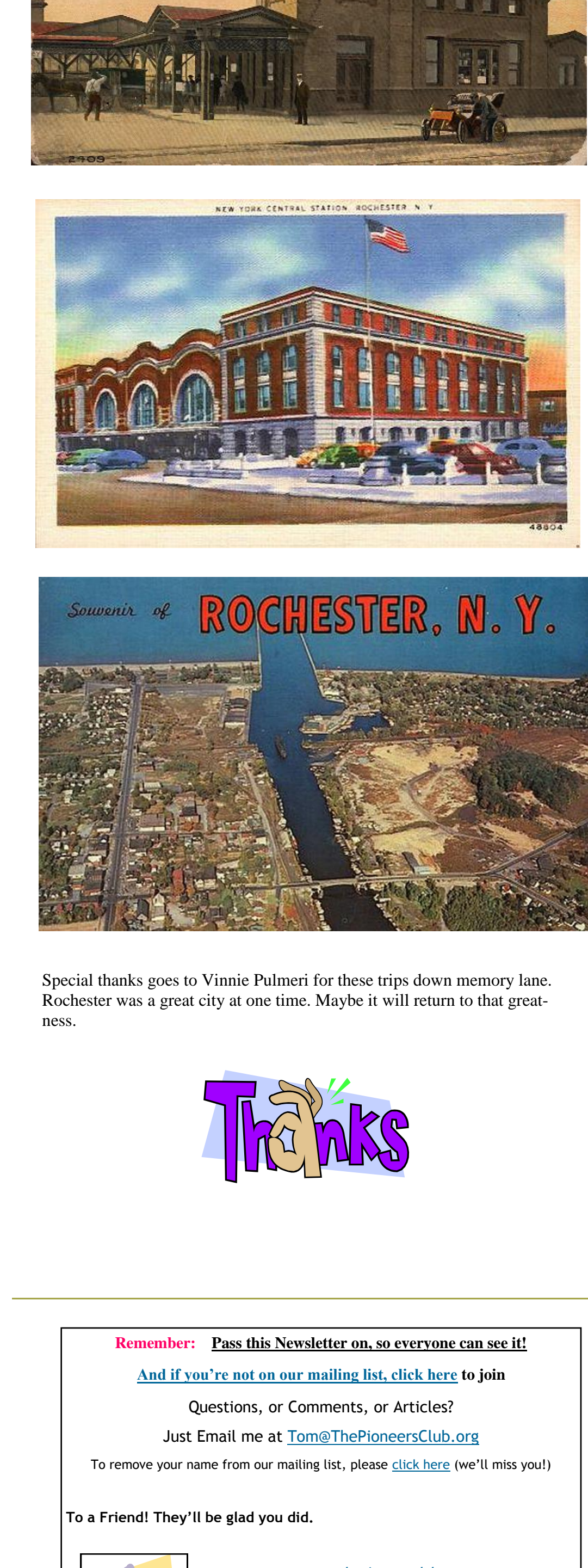
