Well anyway I got a brief note from one of the returning members.

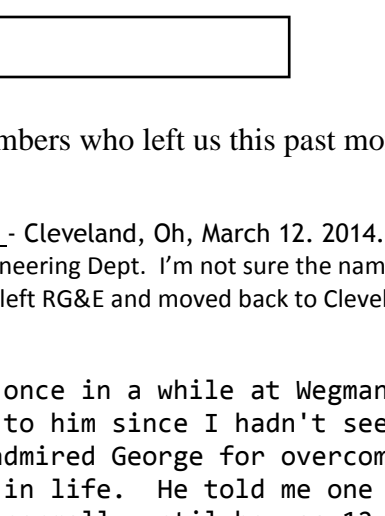

Remembrance:

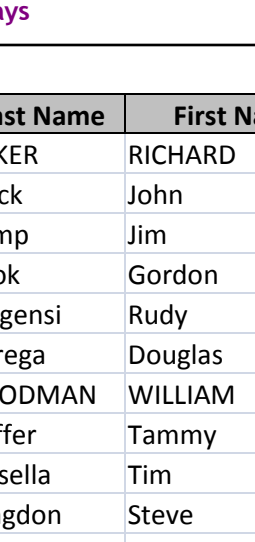

William R. "Bill" Schlegel - Webster NY, March 23, 2014, at 82. Bill retired from the Electric Distribution Engineering.

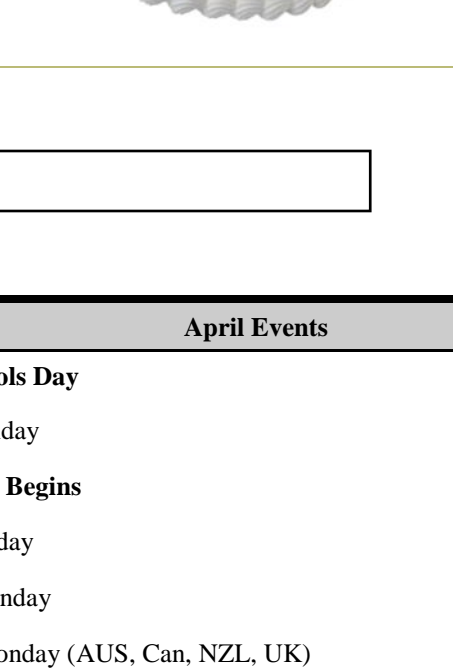
Augustino "Tedo" D'Aurizio - Pittsford, NY, March 22, 2014. Tedo retired from General Maintenance.

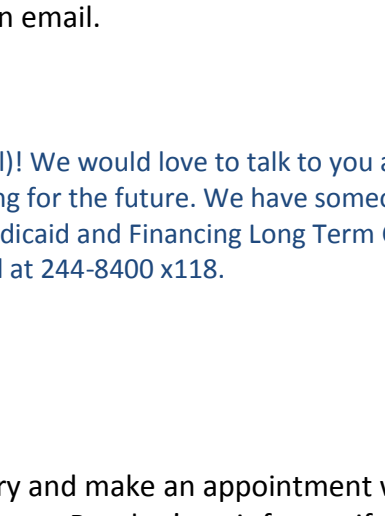
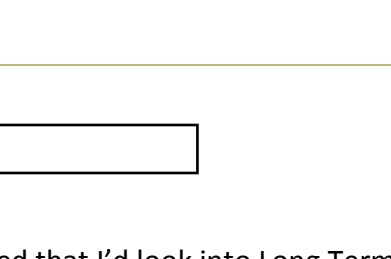

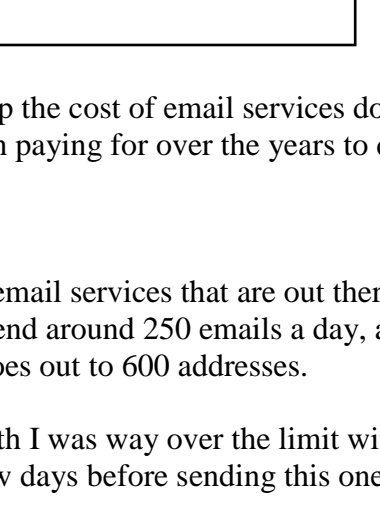

Late Newsletter

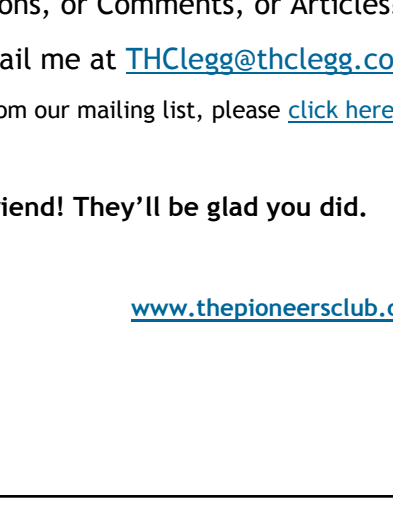
In an effort to keep the cost of email services down, I did not renew the extra emails I have been paying for over the years to deliver this newsletter
