Volunteers interested in helping are welcome. Suggestions to improve the format are also encouraged.

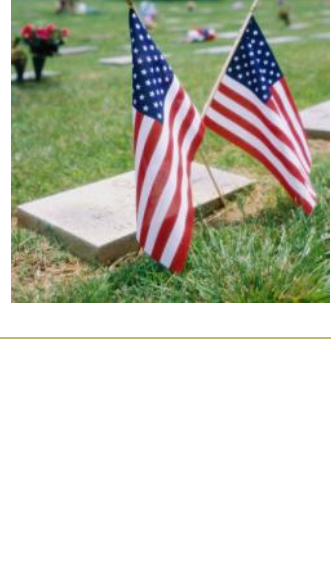
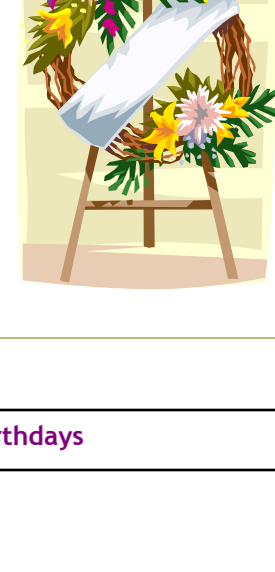

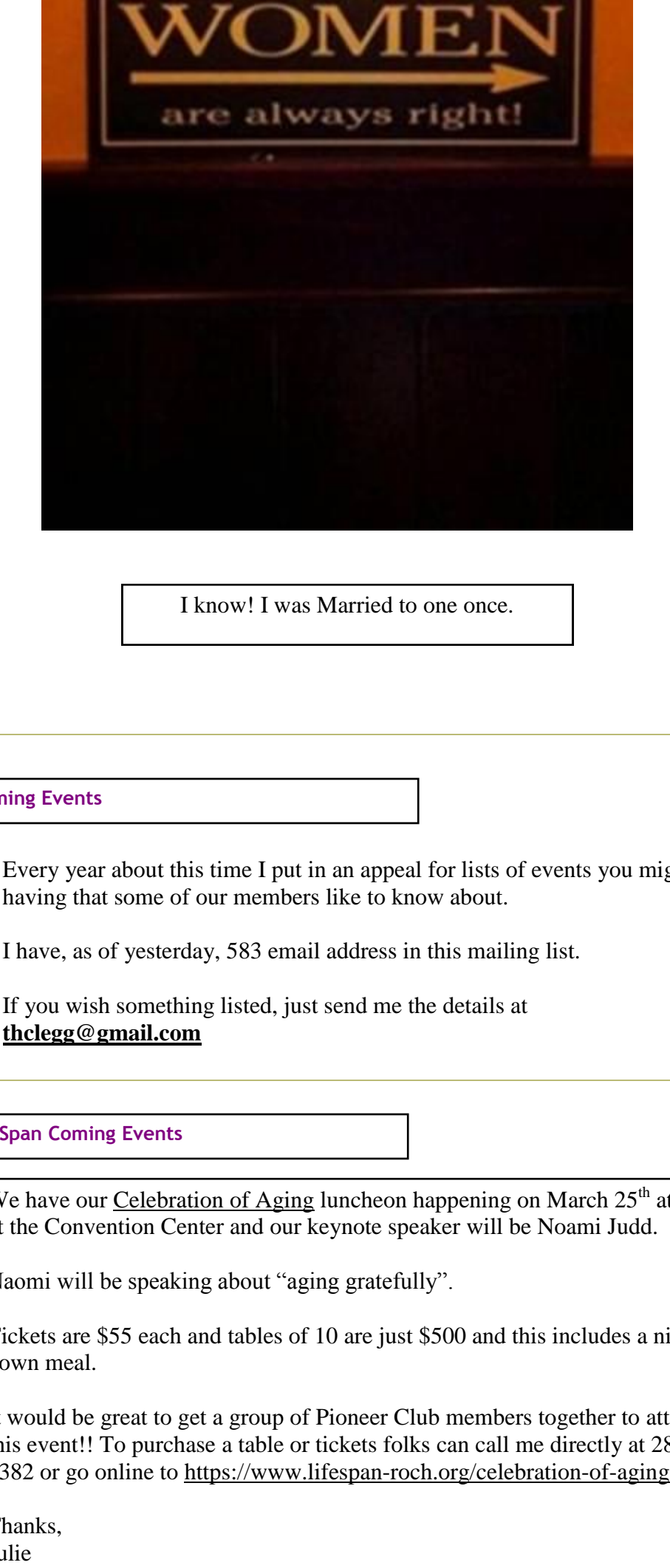
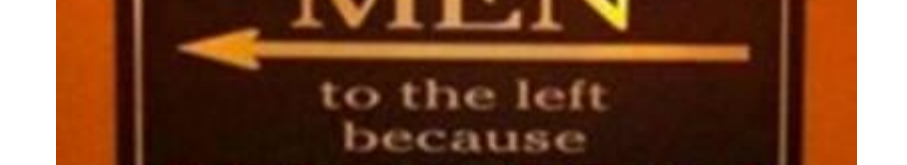
Now I didn't have time today to drive over there and scope it out but if someone does I would appreciate it. I'll print it here next month.
