



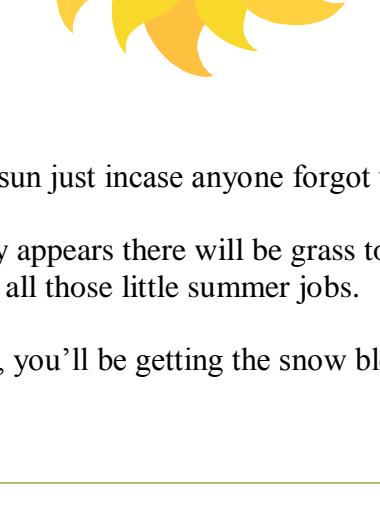

And before you know it, you'll be getting the snow blower back out again.

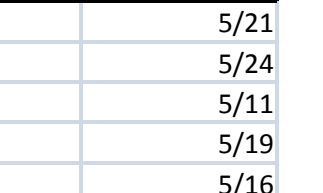
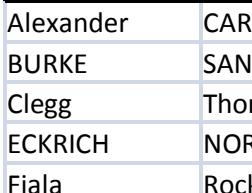
Obituary Page

Robert E. Holloran- Holly, NY, April 15, 2014 at age 80. He retired from General Maintenance at Front St.

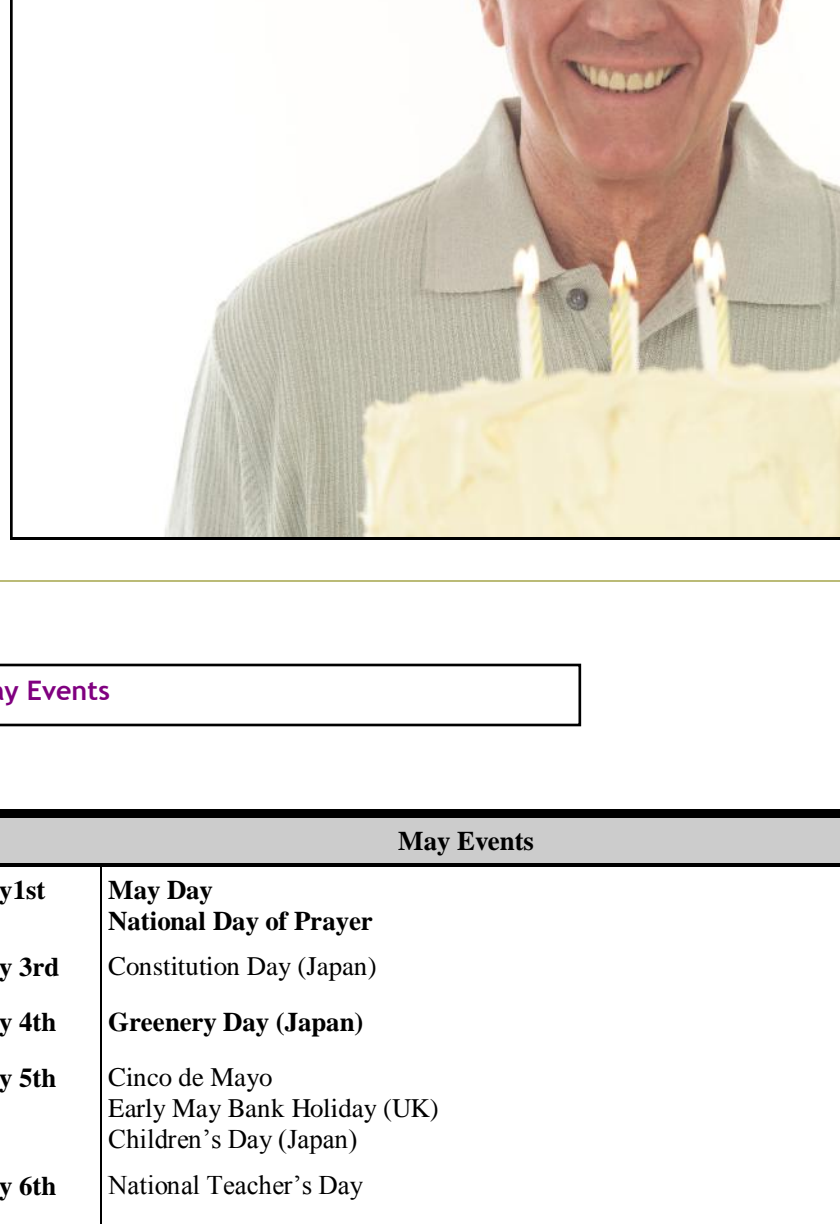
Mary Margaret R. Carney- Webster, NY, April 14, 2014 at age 81. She was employed at Ginna.

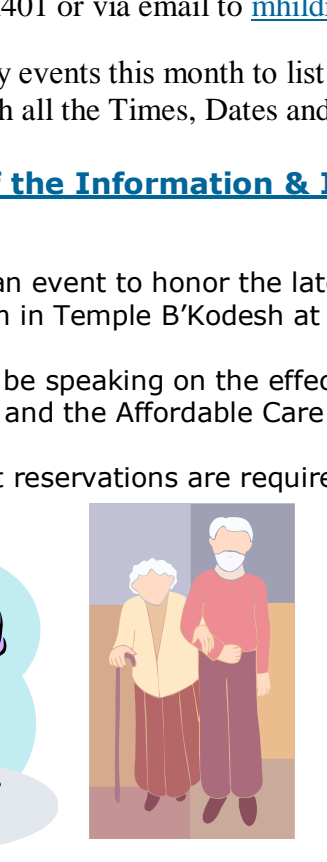
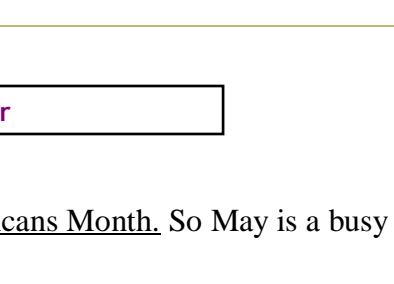

We hope you can spare a minute or two in your busy day to attend. For they sacrificed a lot more for us.

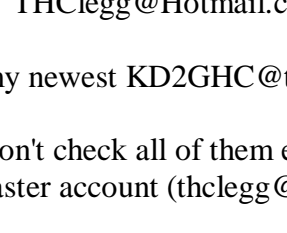


Substations Moved?
